Report 2009 and Program 2010, Medical committee FMJD



1) Report 2009

- Out of the completion test

According to our 2009 program 2009 and confirmed by the Executive Board meeting in May 2009 at Salou, our main activity was the introduction of a small number of out of competition tests. Regarding this, we sent a request for information (whereabouts information for players) to the federations and then selected 2 federations (Mali and Senegal) with 10 players (5 from each country) to be candidates for out of competition tests. From these candidates a final selection of 4 players was made for the tests (2 from each country). The test was carried out by the National Anti Doping Organizations of Mali. At the end, we performed all four tests in Mali, because the fly to Senegal (paid by the ministry of sport of Mali) has been canceled by the airline for the doping test agent.

After urine sample collection September 26, 2009, the four samples have been sent to an accredited laboratory (Agence Francaise de lute contre le dopage, France) The laboratory received on October 1st 2009.

The analysis report has been received on October 14th 2009 and was negative for all tests.

- In competition test.

In our program 2009, we expected to perform an in competition test as well during the world championship in Brazil but unfortunately this major event has been canceled. So we didn't carry out any in competition test.

- Meeting/ training/seminar in 2009.

The Chair man of Medical Committee participated to the FMJD EB meeting in Salou (May 2009).

The Chair man of the M C participated to the Regional Training for Sport Medicine and Doping, where many countries (Senegal, Mali, Burkina Faso, Cote d'ivoire, Mauritania, Niger, ...) had they representative. This training was organized by the Malian National Olympic Committee during the second half of July 2009.

A member of M C (Adama Gueye) participated to the symposium of Strasbourg in Therapeutic use Exemptions (first week of December 2009).

The M C will be well represented for the GA in Berlin (end of December 2009), by two members (**Mr. Adama Gueye** (Senegal) and **Mr. Daan van Os** (Holland)).

To sum up, our 2009 planning was executed almost at 100% with more capacity reinforced for the members in term of seminar and workshop participation to fight against doping in sport in general and in Draughts in particular.



We thank all the support from all the members of the FMJD Executive Board, special thank to the present FMJD Vice President Mr. Otten who take all opportunities with him everywhere to get more deep clarification and bright responses about doping issue for our committee.

And finally, we might have a strong evidence to claim our membership to IOC since we are now fully compliant with the WADA 2009 code, the new code which entered into force on January 2009.

2) Program 2010.

During year 2010, the Medical Committee of FMJD will plan to:

- Perform at least an in competition test for a few selected players during the WC ore another championship under the FMJD responsibility. Also an out of the competition test (maybe in new design advice by WADA) if it's still required from the WADA despite of the request from IMSA to take it off from mind sport.
- Seek for international partnership (laboratories or international organization) which may take in charge or reduce the doping analysis cost as in other IF.
- Have some members to participate to one or two workshop/training related to doping control procedure/technique or about Sport Medicine in general.
- Have more representatives in others continents if they are willing to.
