

Report from WCDF to FMJD for GA 2009 at Berlin on 28/29 December 2009

1. The World Ladies GAYP Challenge Match 2008 between Jan Mortimer (New Zealand) and World Ladies GAYP Champion Amangul Durdyeva (Turkmenistan) was not played. Jan Mortimer defaulted.

2. The World 3-Move Challenge Match 2009 between Ron King (Barbados) and World 3-Move Champion Alex Moiseyev (USA) played at Medina OH from 5 to 15 October was drawn 4-4-32. Alex Moiseyev therefore remains World 3-Move Champion.

3. The World Ladies 3-Move Challenge Match 2009 between Javzan Gerelchuluun (Mongolia) and World Ladies 3-Move Champion Amangul Durdyeva (Turkmenistan) was not played. Javzan Gerelchuluun withdrew.

4. The winner of the World GAYP Qualifying Tournament 2009 played on the Isle of Wight from 1 to 4 September was Richard Beckwith (USA). The winner of the Ladies Section was Wilma Wolverton (USA) who beat Joan Caws 6-5-5. There was no Youth Section.

5. The World GAYP Challenge Match 2010 between Richard Beckwith (USA) and the World GAYP Champion Ron King (Barbados) is scheduled to be played at Medina OH from 5 to 10 October.

6. There will be no World Ladies GAYP Challenge Match 2010. Wilma Wolverton and Joan Caws have both withdrawn.

7. The World 3-Move Qualifying Tournament 2010 will be played at Dublin, Ireland from 27 to 30 October.
