



WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP BLITZ & RAPID 2015

World Championship Turkish Draughts

Rules & Regulations

1. The organization of the World Championship Rapid&Blitz 2015 has been allotted by the FMJD to the Turkish Draughts Federation (TDF) and will take place from Wednesday, October 7th till Saturday, October 10th.
2. At the same period the 2nd World Championship Turkish Draughts will be played. Technical details will be announced by FMJD-Turkish Draughts Section (FMJD-TDS) separately.
3. General schedule (*details can be changed, depend on number of participants*):

 - ⇒ 20:00 Technical meeting (checking players list)
 - (b) October 8th Thursday
 - ⇒ 08:00 - 09:00 Reception (last applications)
 - ⇒ 10:00 Opening Ceremony
 - ⇒ 11:30 WC Rapid
 - ⇒ 15:30 WC Turkish Draughts
 - (c) October 9th Friday
 - ⇒ 10:00 WC Rapid rounds
 - ⇒ 15:00 WC Turkish Draughts
 - (d) October 10th Saturday
 - ⇒ 9:00 WC Blitz – Qualifications
 - ⇒ 16:00 WC Blitz – final(s)
 - ⇒ 20:00 Closing ceremony
 - (e) October 11th Sunday
 - ⇒ 10:00 FMJD General Assambly

6. Official titles:

- (a) World Champion Rapid
- (b) World Champion Rapid National Teams
- (c) World Championship Blitz
- (d) World Champion Blitz National Teams
- (e) World Champion Turkish Draughts
- (f) Women's World Champion Rapid
- (g) Women's World Champion Rapid National Teams
- (h) Women's World Championship Blitz
- (i) Women's World Champion Blitz National Teams

7. System of competitions:

(a) World Championship Rapid:

⇒ Game rate: 15' + 5''

⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system, 9 rounds.

⇒ Only in case of all criteria of challengers for 1st 3 places will be equal, a tie break should be played (2 games 5'+3'' and if the tie break ends in a draw, than GL tie break with 3'+2'' will be played). If more than two players need to play tie break than one game 5'+3'' will be played during the tie break tournament.

⇒ All rules concerning rapid games and rights – duties of players/referees described in FMJD annexes are valid.

(b) World Championship Blitz:

⇒ Game rate: 5' + 3''

- ⇒ Tournament is planned to be played (depend on number of participants) in Swiss system qualifications (2-4 groups depend on number of participants) followed by round-robin finals (A, B,...) with 12 players each.
- ⇒ Only in case of all criteria of challengers for 1st 3 places will be equal, a tie break should be played (2 games 5' + 3" and if the tie break ends in a draw, than GL tie break with 3' + 2" will be played). If more than two players need to play tie break than one game 3' + 2" will be played during the tie break tournament.
- ⇒ All rules concerning rapid games and rights – duties of players/referees described in FMJD annexes are valid.

(c) World Championships (Rapid/Blitz) National Teams:

- ⇒ Before the tournament each federation announced up to 5 players as a member of national team.
- ⇒ Team classification will be settled up based on results of 3 best members of national team:
 - i. Lowest sum of places
 - ii. if equal – highest sum of points
 - iii. if equal – higher place of best team player decides
- ⇒ For teams with less than 3 players N+1 to the score will be added for absent players, where N=number of participants in the tournament.

(d) World Championship Turkish Draughts:

- ⇒ Game rate: 45'
- ⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system, 9 rounds.
- ⇒ Other details will be defined by FMJD-TDS separately

^{8.} Competition fee is **100€** (each tournament). This should be paid to FMJD before September 10th

^{9.} Any protest to Jury d'Appel should be given in written form (in English) to the main referee not later than 10 minutes after the game. Each protest is valid only after paying a deposit of 100 euro. The deposit will be returned only if a protest will be accepted.

10. Accommodation

- (a) Official package: from the dinner October 7th till Breakfast October 11th (October 12th, for those who are also delegate for FMJD-GA) with hotel room (2-3 persons), breakfast, lunch, dinner.
- (b) Official package is free for up to 3 players (minimum one female) from each federation without debt to the FMJD (including 2015 membership fee) but only valid for players who will play in minimum two of 3 championships. The federation has to inform the FMJD which of their players use this special package.
- (c) For other players/coaches and also accompanying persons, official packages costs 200€ per person (**50€ per day**) and should be paid at the tournament reception.
- (d) Additional days before/after the event costs 50€ per person per day (with breakfast, lunch, dinner)

13. Prize money for World Championships Rapid and Blitz is **€8,000** (net of any tax) will be divided as follows:

Prize money World Championship Rapid/Blitz (each):

⇒ 1 st place	1,000 €
⇒ 2 nd place	600 €
⇒ 3 rd place	500 €
⇒ 4 th place	400 €
⇒ 5 th place	300 €
⇒ 6 th place	250 €
⇒ 7 th place	200 €
⇒ 8 th place	200 €
⇒ 9 th place	200 €
⇒ 10 th place	150 €
⇒ 11 th place	100 €
⇒ 12 th place	100 €

14. Prize money for Women's World Championships Rapid and Blitz is **€2,000** (net of any tax) will be divided as follows:

Prize money World Championship Rapid/Blitz (each):

⇒ 1st place 400 €

⇒ 2nd place 300 €

⇒ 3rd place 200 €

⇒ 4th place 100 €

15. Prize money World Championship Turkish Draughts will be announced separately by FMJD-TDS

16. In the case of something not being clear in the FMJD regulations or in this regulation, the decision will be made by the main referee in consultation with the organization and the FMJD tournament director.
