



World Cup

Every player participating in an event included into the World Cup system gets World Cup points (WCP).

There is a general world cup classification and a women's world cup classification.

Every player receives as world cup points the points scored in the tournament and the first 10 players receive extra bonus points.

The world cup points for a player also depend on the competition status: for a 3 star event the player gets three times these points, for a five star event five times these points, ... etc.

So:

World Cup points = points scored in the tournament + bonus points for top ten players, multiplied by competition factor.

The number of stars, the competition factor, for the event depends on the total prize money for the event.

Getting World Cup points

$$\text{WCP} = \text{factor} * (\text{TP} + \text{Bonus})$$

where:

TP – point scored in the tournament (not more than 2 per each game)

Bonus – bonus points for best 10 players, from place #1 to 10: 100, 70, 50, 40, 35, 30, 26, 24, 22, 20

Factor – depends on competition status.

One star event¹ – factor 1, three stars events – factor =3, five stars event factor =5, seven stars even factor =10

If there is ONE tournament for man/women and tournament is included into World Cup also for Women, than bonus points counted depend on sub-classification only for female players.

Classification

Current score it is best 4 results last 24 months.

Criteria:

1. sum of World Cup points

¹ Number of stars depends on prize money: 1 star – 2000€, 3 stars - 5000€, 5 - 10000€, 7 stars -30000€



2. number of 1st places
3. number of 2nd places
4. number of 3rd places
5. better result in last tournament
6. number of winning games

Intercontinental Cup

This independent classification based on World Cup score for players with rating below 2200 (2050 for women) at the beginning of the 24 month period (or at the end if he/she starts without rating).

The winners

Since 2015 every year, after last World Cup event December FMJD will announce and award winners of World Cup (open/women) and Intercontinental Cup (open/women).

Conditions to be part of World Cup system

All events in the system should meet the following requirements:

- Event is open for all participants with an FMJD rating, preferable also for others.
- Referee with FMJD title FR or IR (FMJD referee or International referee)
- System of the competition should be agreed with FMJD
- Prizes should be divided minimum into:
 - 1 star and 3 stars events: minimum 6 for men and 3 for women
 - 5 stars: minimum 10 for men and 6 for women
 - 7 stars event : minimum 10 for men and 6 for women
- Results should be delivered to FMJD round by round
- On web page of the event and at the playing hall the FMJD logo should be presented
- Number of stars depends on prize level:
 - One star – prizes 2.000€ minimum
 - Three stars – prizes 5.000 € minimum



- Five stars – prizes 10.000 € minimum
- Seven stars – prizes 30.000 € minimum
- Bidding procedure:
 - Applications for World Cup event with information about dates, place, prize money and accommodation conditions should be send to FMJD Tournament Director by the end of April of the previous year
 - If there will be 5 or 6 applications - than list of World Cup events will be closed
 - If there will be more than 6 application, decision will be taken be CD-FMJD. CD is free to take any decision taking into account following goals: to get World Cup events in as many countries as possible, to have events in many countries, to give for players prizes on the level as good as possible, to offer for participants reasonable costs of participation. If there will be more than one application from the same country, FMJD will ask National Federation for the advice.
 - If there will be less than 5 application – all will be accepted and FMJD will call for additional applications with the deadline defined on the end of June.
- The final list of World Cup event will be announced by July 15th
- Accepting tournament as a World Cup event FMJD gives rights to use this name and to be included into the system. Organisers are still fully responsible for theirs events
- Going down with the level of World Cup (less stars) is impossible
- Going up with the level of World Cup is possible not late than 3 months before the event.
